### **Production Hours Log Sheet 2021-2022**

You will keep track of your production hours. Here is what each class level needs each semester:

**10 hours:** Technical Theatre 1, Theatre Arts 1

**20 hours:** Stagecraft, Costuming, Theatrical Makeup, JV Production, Varsity Production Acting, Varsity Production Technical Theatre

**You may earn these by completing any of the following for any PHS Theatre Production:**

- Working front of house
- Auditioning
- Being cast an actor or a crew member
- Assisting after school in rehearsals
- Working fine arts events in the auditorium
- Attending productions at PHS (proof of attendance required)
- Attending productions outside of PHS (proof of attendance required)
- Other opportunities as they present themselves

Hours are accumulated like clock hours. So if you spend 2 hours after school working in the scene shop, you will earn 2 production hours.

**Fall Semester: Due by FRIDAY DECEMBER 10.**

**Spring Semester: Due by FRIDAY MAY 13.**

**This is a test grade. Failing to complete the required hours may result in failing the semester or the course.**

**Step 1:** Fill out the Date, Event Description and the number of hours you received.

**Step 2:** Have your log sheet signed by a Theatre teacher (Kirkley, Joyce, or Kulmann)

**Step 3:** Submit the form by the due date. You can submit it any time. You can also work ahead. Attach any proof of attendance to the sheet.

You will use the same sheet all year. If you are in more than one theatre class, you only need to complete one sheet.
